DURATION Approx 1 hour

The renewal process is designed for those who are maintaining currency within the traffic control industry. Persons who have been unable to maintain currency will be required to attend Refresher Training.

To be eligible to renew your Traffic Controller & Implement Traffic Control Plans photo card, all applicants must:

- Complete an application form
- Present your current (or recently expired within 3 months) original photo cards
- Provide an account of relevant traffic control duties for the card being renewed, within the past 12 months (complete a declaration)
- Provide an employer declaration
- Provide a current photograph to be used on the new card

ELIGIBILITY

- Your current photo cards were obtained after the 1st July 2015
- Your tickets haven't yet expired OR have expired within the last 90 days
- You can provide evidence of currency in traffic control duties (12 months)

COURSE CONTENT

- This application process aims to ensure participants have the skills to manage traffic through and/or past a roadwork site, direct traffic with a stop/slow bat or similar control device, and to set up and work with Traffic Control Guidance Plans in accordance with approved Traffic Management Plans.
- To work as a Traffic Guidance Officer in NSW, it is a Roads & Maritime Services requirement that you hold a current Traffic Controller and Implement Traffic Control Plans photo card. These photo cards are valid for a period of 3 years.

Upon completion of this application process, participants will receive RMS issued photo cards via post.
